- Why this matters: Demonstrates knowledge of core system features.

Example Question 3: Real-World Scenario

- **Question:** A project is facing delays. What is the first step a project manager should take to evaluate the root cause of delays in Oracle Project Management Cloud?
- A. Immediately re-baseline the project.
- B. Conduct an earned value analysis and identify variances
- C. Blame the team members who are assigned to the tasks
- D. Escalate the issue to stakeholders
- Why this matters: Tests your ability to apply your knowledge to resolve typical project issues.

Sample Interview Questions
